Why Maggie got involved



"I have attended St. Paul's for 36 years. I became involved in Prayer Ministry when the Bridge was founded and I was asked to coordinate the Prayers of the People. I agreed so long as the prayers would be prepared by and led by members of the congregation. The prayer leaders knew that I prayed for them as they prepared their material. Just over 5 years ago, I was asked to switch to the 11 a.m. service and take on the same role. The Lord led me to expand the prayer ministry such that all the prayer leaders and those involved in Intercessory Prayer Ministry would pray for all those playing a leadership role in our time of worship. So, at the start of each week, I send out a Call to Prayer to over 30 volunteers committed to prayer with the names of those actively involved on the following Sunday." - Maggie
