

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

## 5 Tips on inviting someone to Alpha



**1. Prayer.** Pray for your friend, brother-in-law, cousin or co-worker - anyone who has questions about life, faith or God. Pray they might accept your invitation to begin, or resume, their faith journey at Alpha.



**2. Give someone an invite card from St. Paul's Central.** These invite cards provide all the details (time and location) about our Alpha Launch. Take a couple cards and hand them to people in your life you would like to invite. Inviting someone is a casual way of sharing your faith with others.



**3. Share a digital invite.** Visit [stpaulsbloor.org/tryalpha](http://stpaulsbloor.org/tryalpha) and download or right-click "Save image as" one of the 4 digital invites. You can text, email or share them on Facebook. You can also send the URL to a friend as it has all the details about Alpha.



**4. Invite someone to "try" with you.** Offer to go with them to Alpha Launch on **September 19** to try it out. Let your guest know at Alpha, there is no pressure, no follow-up and it's free of charge. You might say, "I am going to check this event out, would you like to come with me?" and offer to commute together.



**5. Share your own story.** If you've participated in Alpha, share your testimony with someone. Your story is powerful. Let people know how Alpha affected your life or the life of someone you know.
